- Students have the right to appeal through AIE's complaints and appeals process, in accordance with the standard 10 (Complaints and appeals) of the National Code 2018, within 20 working days. The deferment, suspension or cancellation will not take effect until the internal appeals process is completed, unless the overseas student's health or well-being, or the well-being of others, is likely to be at risk.

**Please note:** It is advised that students should have a valid deferment or suspension, because abandoning your studies might lead to cancellation of your visa and you may not be allowed to enter into Australia.
